1) To install Java 8\_112, please <u>Right click and select "Open Hyperlink"</u>.

- 2) Click "Run" when prompted in the browser. For any User Account Control pop-ups select "Yes".
- 3) Click on the "**Install**" button in the Java set up screen and follow the instructions provided. <u>DO NOT</u> check, the "Change destination folder."
- You <u>may</u> receive the below notification. If prompted, click the "Remind Me Later" button to proceed and contact your local IT support. This will ensure limited impact on other Java-dependent applications.



 If prompted, click next on the below screen. <u>DO NOT uncheck the "Restore Java security prompts"</u> box. After the installation has completed you will be alerted of a successful installation. Click on "Close".

- 6) Your default browser will open after installation has completed. Close Browser <u>DO NOT click "Verify</u> Java version."
- 7) After installation is complete, access the Java Control Panel:

Start > Control Panel > Java

Note: You can also verify the installed version via the, "About" button on the General tab.

- 8) Click on the "Update" Tab,
  - a. <u>Uncheck</u> the box for "Check for Updates Automatically".
  - b. Select "Do Not Check" in the pop up.
  - c. DO NOT click on the "Update Now" at the bottom of the tab.
  - d. Click the "Apply" button.
- 9) Click on the "Security" tab. Change the Security Level to High; hit "**Apply**" and then "**OK**" to close the Java Window.



- 10) Click on "**Edit Site List**" under Exception Site List add the following URL for Documentum, Accept any pop-up messages that may appear. Tip: Use CTRL +C and CTRL +V to copy and paste.
  - i. **Documentum:** https://collaborationspace.ge-energy.com/
- 11) After adding the URL, hit "Apply" and then "OK" to close the Java Window.

Note: For previous versions of Java, change the Security Level to Medium; and follow the above instructions.

12) Clear browser cache and close all browser sessions.

Internet Explorer:

- a. Open Internet Explorer.
- b. From the Tools menu choose Internet Options.
- c. On the General tab, under Browsing history, click "Delete"
- d. Un-check the Preserve Favorites website data box.
- e. Check the Temporary Internet files, Cookies, and History boxes.
- f. Click the Delete button.
- g. Click the "Apply" and then "OK" button.

Firefox:

- a. Click the menu button and choose Options.
- b. Select the Advanced panel.
- c. Click on the Network tab.
- d. In the Cached Web Content section, click "Clear Now".
- e. Click "**OK**" to close the Options window.
- 13) Open a new session and begin using Documentum. If prompted with the below pop-up please follow the on screen instructions.
