- 2) Click **"Run"** when prompted in the browser. For any User Account Control pop-ups - select **"Yes"**.
- 3) Click on the **"Install"** button in the Java set up screen and follow the instructions provided. **DO NOT check, the "Change destination folder."**
- 4) You may receive the below notification. If prompted, click the **"Remind Me Later"** button to proceed and contact your local IT support. This will ensure limited impact on other Java-dependent applications.



- 5) If prompted, click next on the below screen. **DO NOT** uncheck the **“Restore Java security prompts”** box. After the installation has completed you will be alerted of a successful installation. Click on **“Close”**.



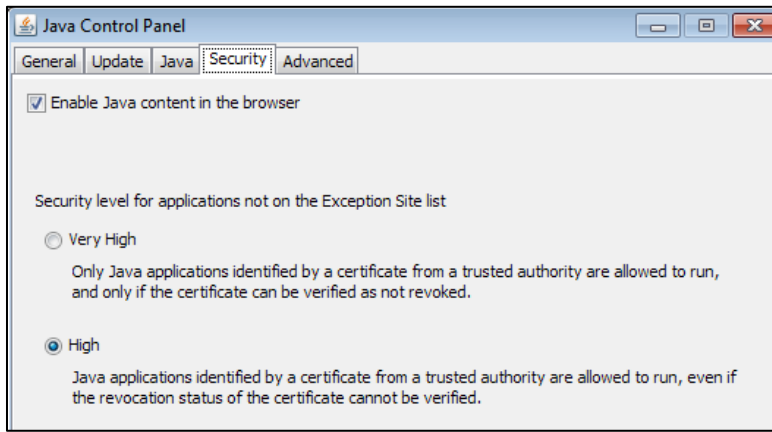
- 6) Your default browser will open after installation has completed. Close Browser – **DO NOT** click **“Verify Java version.”**

- 7) After installation is complete, access the Java Control Panel:

Start > Control Panel > Java

Note: You can also verify the installed version via the, **“About”** button on the **General** tab.

- 8) Click on the **“Update”** Tab,
- Uncheck the box for **“Check for Updates Automatically”**.
 - Select **“Do Not Check”** in the pop up.
 - DO NOT** click on the **“Update Now”** at the bottom of the tab.
 - Click the **“Apply”** button.
- 9) Click on the **“Security”** tab. Change the Security Level to High; hit **“Apply”** and then **“OK”** to close the Java Window.



10) Click on **“Edit Site List”** under Exception Site List add the following URL for Documentum, Accept any pop-up messages that may appear. Tip: Use CTRL +C and CTRL +V to copy and paste.

11) After adding the URL, hit **“Apply”** and then **“OK”** to close the Java Window.

Note: For previous versions of Java, change the Security Level to Medium; and follow the above instructions.

12) Clear browser cache and close all browser sessions.

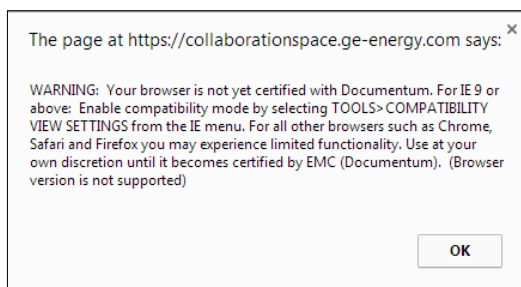
Internet Explorer:

- a. Open Internet Explorer.
- b. From the Tools menu choose Internet Options.
- c. On the General tab, under Browsing history, click **“Delete”**
- d. Un-check the Preserve Favorites website data box.
- e. Check the Temporary Internet files, Cookies, and History boxes.
- f. Click the Delete button.
- g. Click the **“Apply”** and then **“OK”** button.

Firefox:

- a. Click the menu button and choose Options.
- b. Select the Advanced panel.
- c. Click on the Network tab.
- d. In the Cached Web Content section, click **“Clear Now”**.
- e. Click **“OK”** to close the Options window.

13) Open a new session and begin using Documentum. If prompted with the below pop-up please follow the on screen instructions.
